



2019 S.N.E.S.A Academic Scholarship

The Southern New England Saddlebred Association (SNESA) academic scholarship will be awarded to a SNESA member who has worked to fulfill the club's mission to promote the American Saddlebred to individuals outside of the horse industry.

Due Date: Event portfolio and application form must be submitted by the end of Octoberfest horseshow (11/3/2019).

Eligible candidate to apply: Any SNESA member who is a high school student planning to pursue an undergraduate education.

Maximum Amount Awarded: \$750

Scholarship Description: The applicant must host an American Saddlebred promotional event for their community. This event can be anything that will inform or promote the American Saddlebred to individuals unfamiliar with the breed.

An event portfolio and completed application form are required for the consideration of the award. An event portfolio will include: documentation of pre-planning, flyers/promotional items used, pictures of the event, and a written summary including the personal take-away from the event. American Saddlebred promotional materials (i.e. pamphlets, coloring pages, etc.) are available from ASHA if applicants would like to include them in their event.

The scholarship recipient will be selected by the SNESA officers and Board of Directors. The award will be presented at the SNESA 2019 Year End Banquet.
